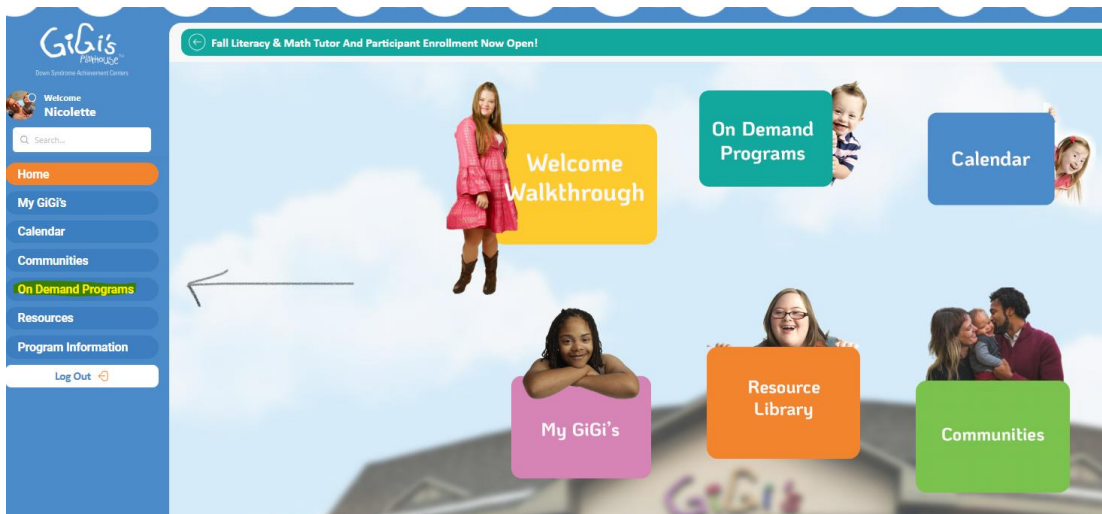


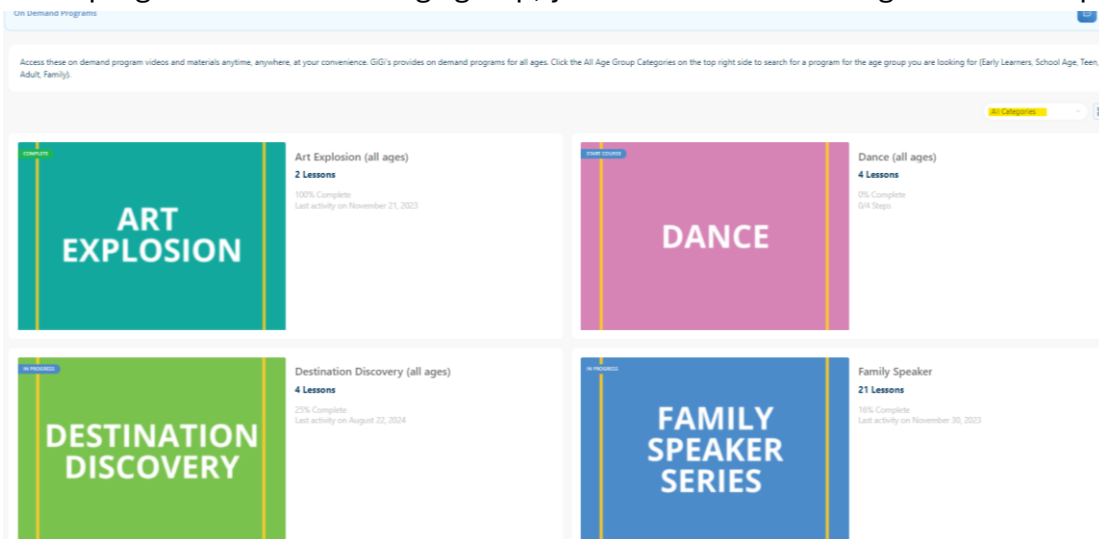
Accessing On Demand Programs once inside the New Virtual Platform

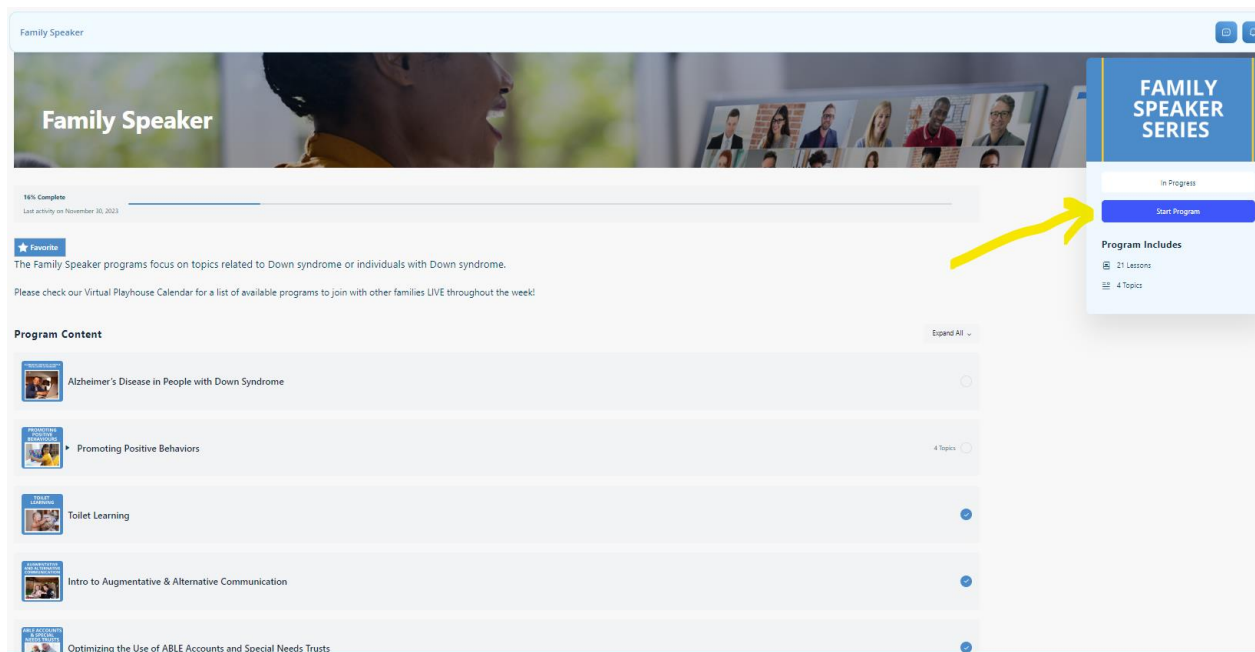
Once you have logged into the New Virtual Platform, you will come to our home screen. You will want to click the button that says “On Demand Programs” on the lefthand side.



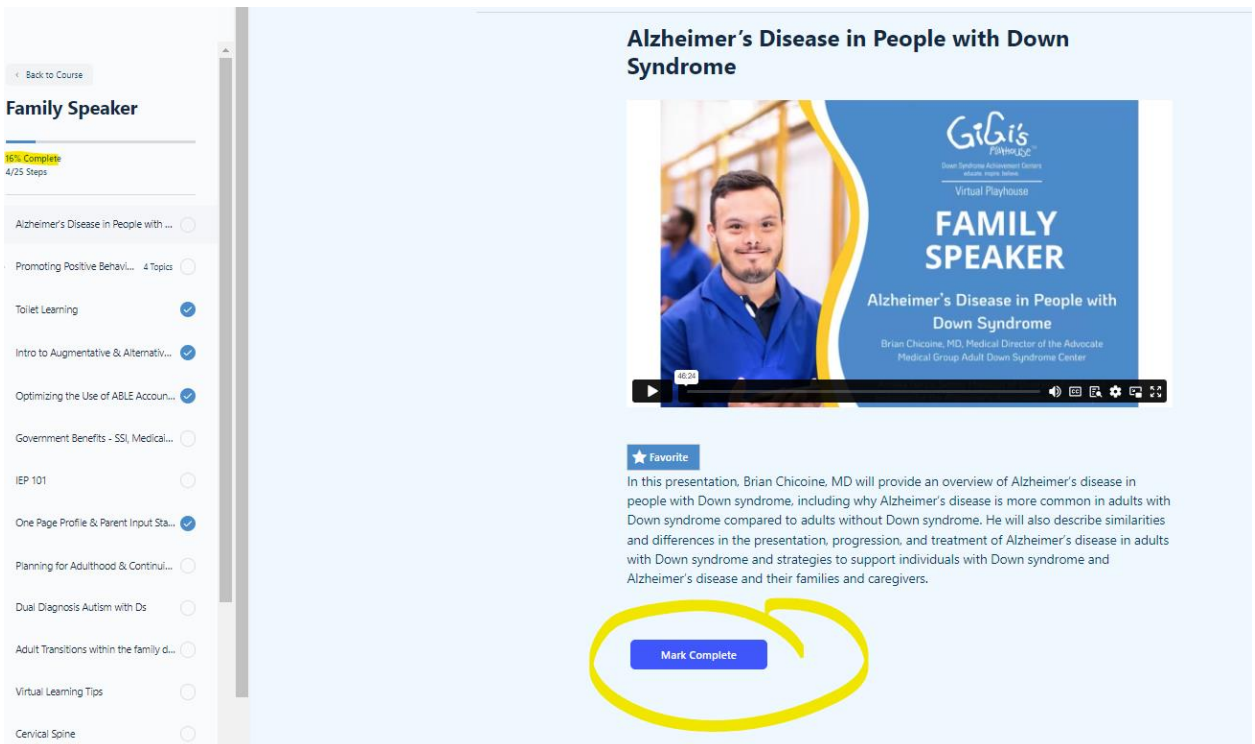
You will then come to a page with a list of all our On Demand Programs courses. Each course has several lessons in them. You can scroll through these courses on this page to find the one you want to watch, or if you want to find programs for a certain age group, you can search the categories in the top right corner.



Click the course you want to watch and then you will see a list of the lesson titles. You can scroll through the lessons to click on the title that interests you, or you can click the button on the top right that says “Start Program” and it will take you through all the lessons.



You will press the “mark complete” button after each lesson and the platform will track your progress for you! (ex: 25% completion) You will see the list of lesson titles on the left side of the screen if you want to jump around to a different lesson instead of going in order.



To get back to the list of On Demand Programs, simply click the button that says this in the menu on the left hand side of the screen, or click your browser's “back” button.
