

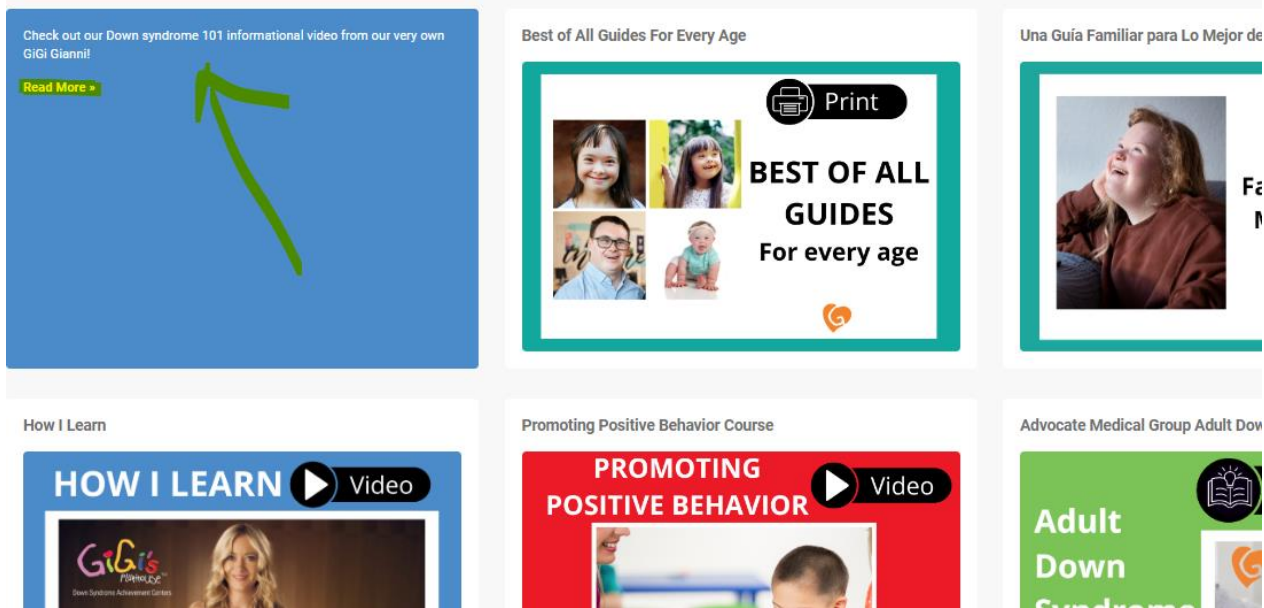
Accessing the Resource Library once inside the New Virtual Platform

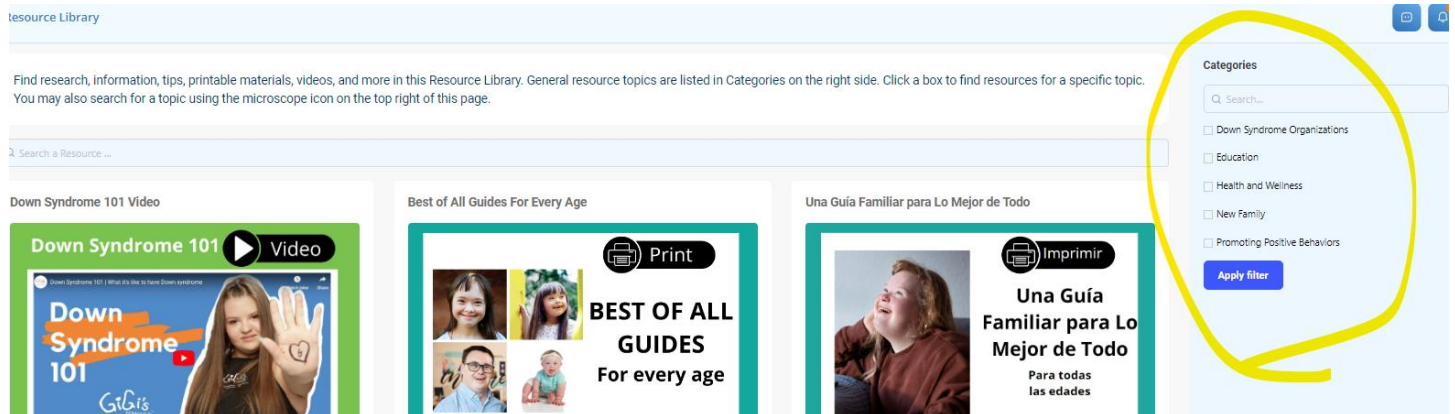
Once you have logged into the New Virtual Platform, you will come to our home screen. You will want to click the button that says “Resources” on the lefthand side.



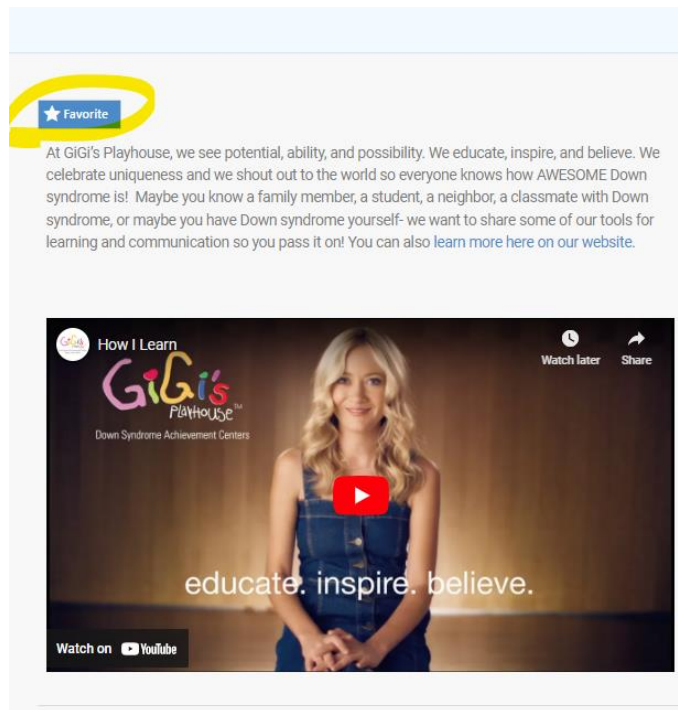
You will then come to a page with a list of all our Resources. When you hover over the resource, a short description of the resource will pop up. You can click on the words **read more** if you are interested in checking out this resource.



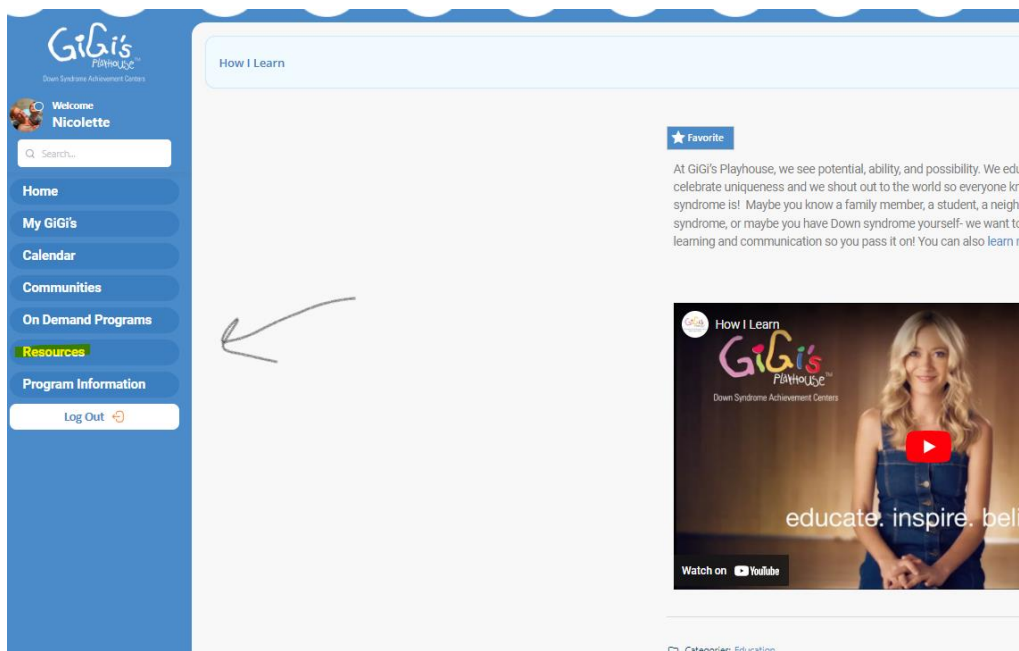
You can scroll through these resources on this page to find the one you want, or if you can filter your search by category in the top right corner.
